The project involves the transformation of five previously tired and energy-inefficient properties into smarter, more energy-efficient homes. Embracing a 'fabric first' strategy, the development focuses on retaining energy within the homes. Cuttingedge technologies, such as the Mixergy Smart Cylinder tank, Air Source Heat Pumps, and 14 PV panels generating 5.6kwh per house, work together to harness and utilize consumed energy. The properties feature new double-glazed windows, insulated front doors, energyefficient built-in appliances, thermal rendering, and EV charging points. The incorporation of smart green technology and appliances aligns with the growing trend among buyers to reduce their carbon footprint and lower energy bills.

Scott Page, Project Manager at Annington, notes, "Marlborough Close marks a significant milestone for Annington. Our 'fabric first' approach and EPC rating target showcase our dedication to long-term carbon reduction in these properties."
