Every home now boasts an energyefficient EPC C rating, having undergone gas and electrical testing, and offers the added convenience of allocated parking. Furthermore, each property has been

redecorated, ensuring a clean and bright atmosphere that rivals the freshness of a brand new home. The layouts encompass open-plan living and dining areas, along with generously proportioned bedrooms with built-in storage.

Lancaster Place is within easy walking distance of all the amenities that the village of Wittering has to offer, including a primary school, convenience stores, takeaways, cafe, parish church and busy village hall which hosts a variety of activities including fitness classes and Scout groups. Wittering has a strong sense of community and plenty to offer. ## WORTHING FIELDS, SWANTON MORLEY

At Worthing Fields, Annington has embarked on an impressive programme to revitalise former military houses and recreate a thriving neighbourhood. These houses have been carefully transformed into comfortable and energy-efficient homes, with solar PV panels, 300mm of loft insulation, and low energy lighting; as a result, they have achieved an EPC C rating. Thorough testing has been conducted on the electrics, water, and lighting systems. Included in the property are new front doors, updated floor coverings, smart new blinds for all windows, timber fences surrounding the rear garden, and a complete redecoration, enhancing the overall aesthetic appeal of these homes

Houses have a variety of layouts, offering ample open-plan living spaces, sizable bedrooms, and in certain instances, an extra room suitable for a separate study or playroom, with each property enjoying the accessibility of allocated parking. Worthing Fields is on the outskirts of Swanton Morley, a small Norfolk village where residents will find various amenities on their doorstep, including a primary school with an Ofsted
